The European Championship Latin Youth, organized by the Ministry of Education, Culture and Research of the Republic of Moldova, the Moldova DanceSport Federation and the DanceSport Club "Codreanca", took place on April 20-21, 2019, in the Palace of the Republic.

3rd place: Marian Hlavac - Tereza Maturova, Czech Republic;

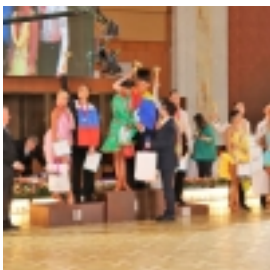
4th place: Nitu Eric Marius - Iosub Antonia Ioana, Romania;
