Chamber of Commerce and Industry France-Moldova - Club France (CCIFM), with the support of Mobiasbanca-Groupe Societe Generale, organized on June 9, 2011, between the hours 8.30-14.30, the third edition of the Business Conference “Trademarks Day”, entitled “Quality Appellations of Origin”. The event will be held at Leogrand Convention Center.

Among organizers are counted the **French Embassy in the Republic of Moldova, the French Alliance in Moldova**, Moldovan and French successful companies.

The main theme of the current edition “Quality Appellations of Origin” is a topical issue for the Republic of Moldova, and French experience is particularly important and recognized in this respect.
