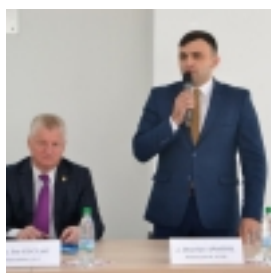

AGEPI specialists have disseminated among the participants informative materials in the field of protection of intellectual property.

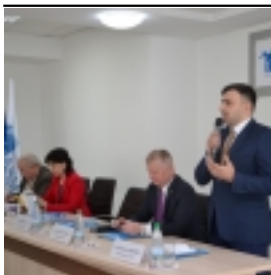
