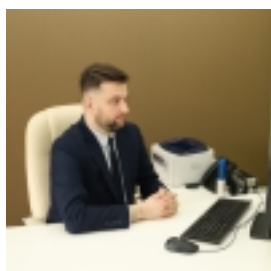
The purpose of the webinar was to encourage women to protect their creations by registering intellectual property rights such as trademarks, design, patents or copyrights.

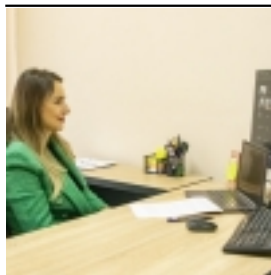

Thus, the participants had the opportunity to better understand the process of protecting their creations and learn how to benefit from their intellectual property rights in an efficient way. In addition, the Digital Innovations and Technology Startups Support Program and the Women’s Entrepreneurship Support Program Concept was presented during the webinar, with the aim of supporting women in developing their businesses and promoting innovations and creativity in various fields. Thus, the event provided valuable opportunities for all participants interested in improving their knowledge and developing their businesses sustainably.
