In the period from November 14 to 15, 2012 the State Agency on Intellectual Property (AGEPI) of Republic of Moldova holds the National Seminar "Intellectual Property for SMEs". The Seminar aims to inform local economic agents on the role and importance of intellectual property objects in SMEs development and increase of their competitiveness on the market, means of creation, protection and exploitation of intangible assets.

At the opening ceremony of the Seminar, welcoming speeches were delivered by Mr. Ion Tiganas, Deputy Director General AGEPI, Ms. Valentina Veverita, Director, SMEs policy development and liberal professions Direction under the Ministry of Economy of the Republic of Moldova, Mrs. Lien Verbaughede Koglin, Consultant, Innovation Division, SMEs Section, World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO).
