In the period 19-21 February 2016, in Balti took place the twentieth edition of the specialized Expo-Fairs “AGROTEH”, “Alimentar Expo” and the eleventh edition of the show “Martisor” organized by the Chamber of Commerce and Industry of the Republic of Moldova (CCI), Balti branch.

The program of the event included practical seminars, company presentations, workshops, bilateral dialogues and the employment fair.

Manufacturers have proposed machines and agricultural machinery, means of plant protection, fertilizers, a wide variety of seeds, seedlings of fruit and decorative trees, vine cuttings, flowers.
